Description of community agency/organization:

BYS is a culturally relevant prevention and intervention wrap around school and community support initiative that holds the student and his/her family at the center.

Our goal is to support up to approximately 1000 (500 in 5 years) Black children and youth in grades 6-8 and for all four years of high school to achieve graduation or be on track to achieve graduation rates on par with the regional average by 2026.

Position title: Online Tutor/Homework Support

What will the student do:

- Review homework questions/concerns and provide feedback on assignments.
- Deliver a mini micro-teach on STEM related topics. Making learning real, relevant and rigorous.
- Provide participants with relevant STEM activities/resources to enhance the learning experience/outcomes.

Skills required:

- Excellent interpersonal/communication skills.
- Strong in the following middle & high school academic subjects: Science/Math/French.
- Time Management (available twice a week to provide online student support).
- Be: Available, Engaging and Professional.

Skills student will learn:

- To develop their skills in communication and ability to effectively facilitate a small group session.
- To grow/expand their professional and social network.
- To develop skills in leadership that can help them during group projects in academic and career settings.

Our volunteers will have the opportunity to provide weekly tutoring/homework support on: **Tuesdays or Thursdays between 3 pm and 5pm**.
